Phase I Detour for Castle Creek Bridge / Hallam Street Improvement Project Begins Friday
New traffic pattern begins April 6, 2018

Aspen, CO – Project crews are able to mobilize the phase I detour beginning at approximately 7 a.m. on Friday, April 6. This is a change in the schedule (originally this shift was set to occur April 9). This traffic pattern will be in effect 24/7 for approximately the next month when phase II begins. Significant traffic delays are anticipated during peak travel times for both inbound and outbound traffic.

“Crews have reached a point where they can mobilize the phase I traffic configuration,” said project manager, Hailey Guglielmo. “This detour is similar to the typical s-curve pattern, but with inbound traffic using Sixth Street to Main and outbound traffic using Fifth Street to Hallam.”

Working hours will continue to be from approximately 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday-Friday and some Saturdays. Weather permitting, it is anticipated that crews will work this Saturday, Apr. 7. This detour will continue to be in effect through nights and over the weekends. Outbound motorists are urged to use both lanes until the merge point.

Emergency service vehicles will use the same routes as general traffic. Motorists are reminded to move over for EMS. Anyone who blocks emergency services vehicles is subject to citation and fines. Blocking intersections will not be tolerated. Be aware, follow detour signage and flagger instruction.
