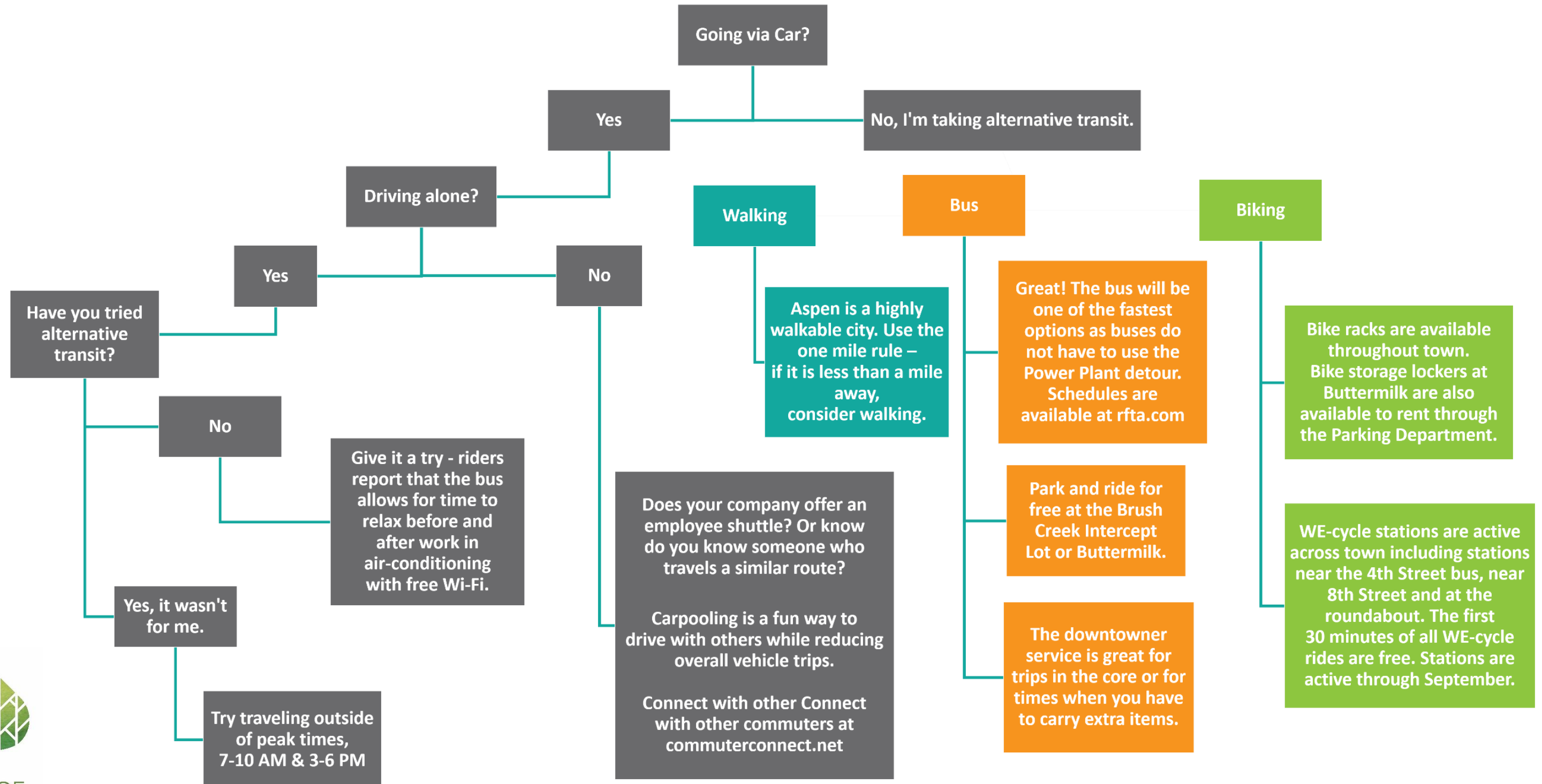


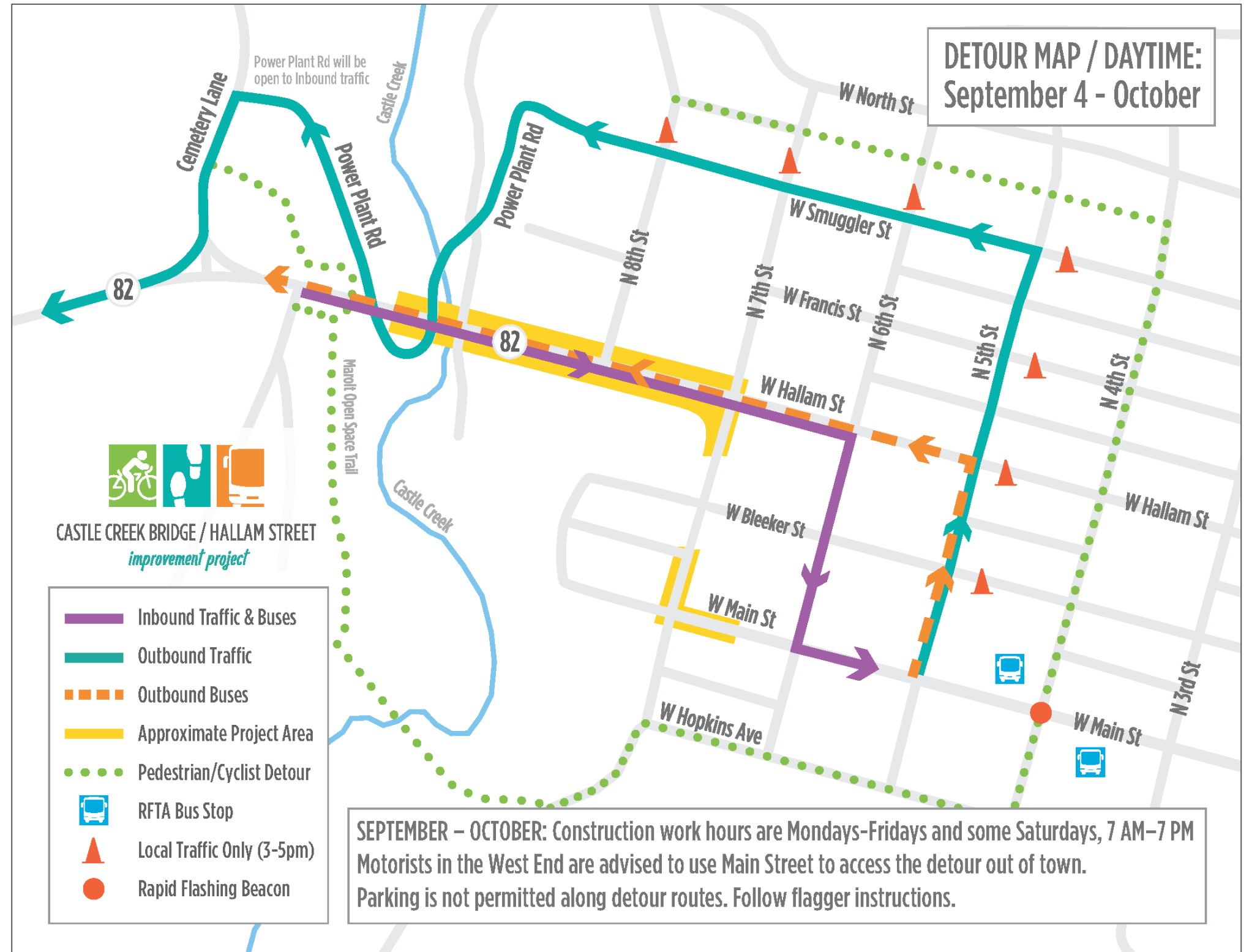

Road detours and construction for the Castle Creek Bridge / Hallam Street Improvement Project resumes September 4 through October 31.

KEY PROJECT INFORMATION:

- Detours and construction will resume for approximately two months, September 4 through October 31.
- Heavy delays are anticipated for both inbound and outbound traffic (Peak times: 7-10 AM & 3-6 PM).
- Work hours are 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Work is weather dependent.
- A pedestrian and cyclist detour will be in effect via Marolt Open Space Trail. It is prohibited to enter the work area.
- Phase III work activities will include work on the bus shelters, the bridge sidewalk extensions, drainage improvements, rail installation, bridge paving, striping and landscaping.

The Castle Creek Bridge / Hallam Street Improvement Project seeks to improve safety and function for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists on the busiest street in Aspen, CO. Key project components include: a protected 8-foot-wide concrete trail, upgraded bus shelters, repaired roadway and improved intersections at both seventh and eighth street. These improvements will increase user safety, promote multi-modal connectivity, upgrade our public transportation infrastructure and enhance corridor aesthetics.
